
Visualizing the Pilgrimage of the Gospel of the Covenant

Instead of confessing their sin and repenting, their sin becomes habitual. They find themselves intransigent in their unrepentance. If they stay hardened and unrelenting in their sin, they forfeit eternal life!



Thoughts to Consider:

- Have you kept indulging yourself in the same sin(s) without confessing and repenting?
- Do you allow yourself to be put in tempting situations such as watching sensual TV shows or movies or internet, or hanging out with people who entice you into harmful behaviors?
- Does the thought of ever becoming an intransigent unrepentant terrify or shake you?
- Does the thought of forfeiting all hope of eternal life inspire in you a firmer resolve to resist temptation and return to a life in Christ of sanctification and transformation?
